Subj: First Quarter 2009 RCD Report

A big 'thank you' to club Governors for adapting to the new Sanction Request form in the Excel format. And, a big 'thank you' in advance for your 2009 result spreadsheets being correct with full names as listed on the region membership lists provided by Ron Scott (RMD). These are mandated from national.

#### Sanctions:

- To date, 35 Sanction Requests have been approved and there are still dates on hold for EPCC (Silver City NM 7/18-19) and DCA (Scottsdale AZ 9/5-6).
- I encourage Governors of clubs that do not plan to use all their available sanctions (7 per club per year) to make them available to other clubs that are willing to put on sanctioned events for the regions members. In 2008, the region had a total of 60 sanctioned events and 31 event club sanctions were not used. Your sanctions can help create more events with the region, so I thank you in advance. Contact me to donate your unused sanctions.
- I will notify the clubs that need them and distribute them equitably.

#### 2008 Awards:

- The region received \$92.00 from NCCC to be applied toward the cost of region awards for 2008.
- NCCC provides region patches for the overall first place club and the top 3 men and ladies overall each year. These will probably be given to me at the May national meeting. I will distribute them as soon as I receive them.
- Region awards for 2009 will be distributed at the DCA Sweetheart Car Show on Sunday, February 15<sup>th</sup> immediately before the Governor's meeting. The final costs for the awards was \$1,872.07. Note, duplicate awards were required for a 3-way tied fifth place award. Receipts will be available at the Governors Meeting.
  - Trophy plaques for NCCC individual overall awards and club plaques - \$837.43.
  - Region awards for individuals, including embroidery - \$1,0343.64
  - I was provided an advance of \$1,700 for 2008 awards.
  - I am requesting \$172.07 to repay me for the difference from the advance and the actual final total cost of awards.

Event Insurance Certificates – all clubs should be submitting an Insurance Certificate Request to K&K for every event. I know some clubs do, but some do not. According to word received by the region officers from NCCC national, these are required for every sanctioned event, as well as events which have a “non-sanction number” assigned. To quote George Gallant, Business Manager of NCCC, “If wheels are turning at an event, an Insurance Certificate is required.” Please remember that all events are covered up to \$1 million liability unless you request, and pay for, increased coverage (rates are on the form). The online form cannot be saved, but can be filled out and printed.

Please remember that each NCCC club Governor’s is responsible for supporting the NCCC Competition Program and the other region clubs by:

- Ensuring that all club members are made aware of all region sanctioned events.
- Notifying region officers and Governors of their club’s events so members of all other clubs can be provided with up-to-date schedules of events.
- Encouraging reciprocal participation at the events of other clubs.
- Ensuring that NCCC rules are followed at all events, and safety is emphasized.
- Submitting all event-related documents, forms, etc. correctly and on time.
- Ensuring that insurance Certificates are requested for events.

Important dates to remember when scheduling and conducting your events:

- Sanction Request due to RCD at least 70 days in advance of the event.
- Event Flyer due to RCD at least 50 days in advance of the event.
  - See the NCCC rulebook for required flyer elements.
  - Although not specified, flyers are strongly recommended to include times that may be helpful to, and of importance to, entrants. These include: stop clean and begin judging times for car shows; time Tech opens and closes for rallies, autocrosses, and drags; time course is closed for walking for autocrosses; etc.
- Event results and copies of signed event waivers are due to RCD from the host club Governor no later than 15 days after the event.
  - RCD will verify that all entrants signed the waivers.
  - RCD will verify NCCC numbers, names, points awarded, etc.
  - RCD will contact submitting Governor to reach agreement on any discrepancies noted.
  - RCD will update region point standings.
  - RCD will send approved final results to the NCCC VP of Competition.
- Host club Governor must send results to all participants no later than 30 days after the event.

\*\*\* Note, the VP of Competition took all points from host clubs and their members for 7 events in 2008. This was because of late submission, failure to correct errors, and/or failure to provide signed waiver copies.
