

## Roadrunner Region RCD Report 2<sup>nd</sup> Qtr – 5/24/08

Updated Mileage Chart is posted on the web site

- ACC declared city is Cave Creek AZ

NMCA has not applied for sanctions on dates “held” since November 2007

- 9/27-28 = 4 events
- 11/1-2 = 3 events

Sanctions Issued:

- ACC October Autocrosses changed to 10/4 (site availability issue)
  - Same day as a PC in Verde Valley
- ACC November autocrosses changed to 11/2 (site availability issue)
  - Was a “hold” day for NMCA

All results through 5/17/08 are posted on the region web site → Top Clubs & people

Event result problems to date in 2008 (22 events):

- RCD has not received any results on the proper forms.
- Event results include a very high number of errors.
- RCD has had to retype results for every club & every event.
- RCD has contacted clubs that hosted events to remind them repeatedly to submit results, but almost all are late.

Event result rules:

- Results **must be** sent to RCD within 15 days of the event.
- Results **must be** prepared using the most current NCCC web site versions of the Excel Spreadsheets for events.
- After any problems are resolved between the Event Club Governor and the RCD, the event host club **must send** official results to all entrants within 30 days of the event.
- Host Club Governors are responsible for the accuracy of results.
- NCCC Rulebook → Late results can cost host club & its members loss of points.
  - Late includes not only first submission, but clubs not responding to fix their errors after being notified.

Event Fees:

- Fees **must be** sent to the Region Treasurer within 15 days of the event.
- Checks **must be** made payable to: NCCC ROADRUNNER REGION
- \$1/Driver in Autocross, Matching Times, and Drags.
- \$1/Corvette in Rallies, People’s Choice, Concours, Funkhanas, and Economy Runs.
- Currently Due
  - TVS – 3 events 4/19-20 = \$38.00
  - TCC – 4 events 4/26-27 = \$45.00

Future Event Result Process:

- RCD will not retype any club's results, but will notify the host club governor of mistakes and request expeditious corrections.
- RCD will notify club if results are in error and on the incorrect forms.
- RCD will begin penalizing clubs for not following the rules.

Event Waivers:

- Copies of signed waivers **must be** sent to RCD within 15 days of the event.
- Copies **must be** the entire waiver form, not simply the signatures.

## National Competition Committee Meeting Report May 2, 2008

Event waivers:

- Many forms in the packet for 2008
- **Throw away all but "Long Form Waiver" and "two-sided Minor Waiver."**
- Short Rallye Waiver is no longer required and regular long form should be used.
- When current supplies are expended, K&K will pursue making the standard waiver form on regular size paper instead of legal size.

Clarifications:

- If a car came from the factory with a "Radio Delete Option" the section in the rulebook that says radios cannot be removed in Groups 1-3 DOES NOT apply.
- Can a Quick Release Steering Wheel be used in Group-1? NO (OK in Group-3)
- Can a C6 that comes with drilled rotors use replacement rotors that are not drilled in Group-1 (OK in Group-2)
- Can a Group-1 car with domed pistons (i.e., 340/360/375 HP 327s) replace them with flat-topped pistons in Group-1 to lower compression & run on today's pump gas? NO (OK in Group-2)

Results – must use standard format

Rulebook changes for 2009?

- Allow +/- ¼" on cat-back exhaust
- Consider tire size leeway in Group-1S
- Consider 11/10/9 points for fastest 3 cars
- One car classes – need to do something?
- Only 1 woman or man – can be a points penalty with the limit of 7
- Shows & rallies now get higher points for 2<sup>nd</sup> place than speed events?
- Study Group – tire size restrictions for Group-1S?
